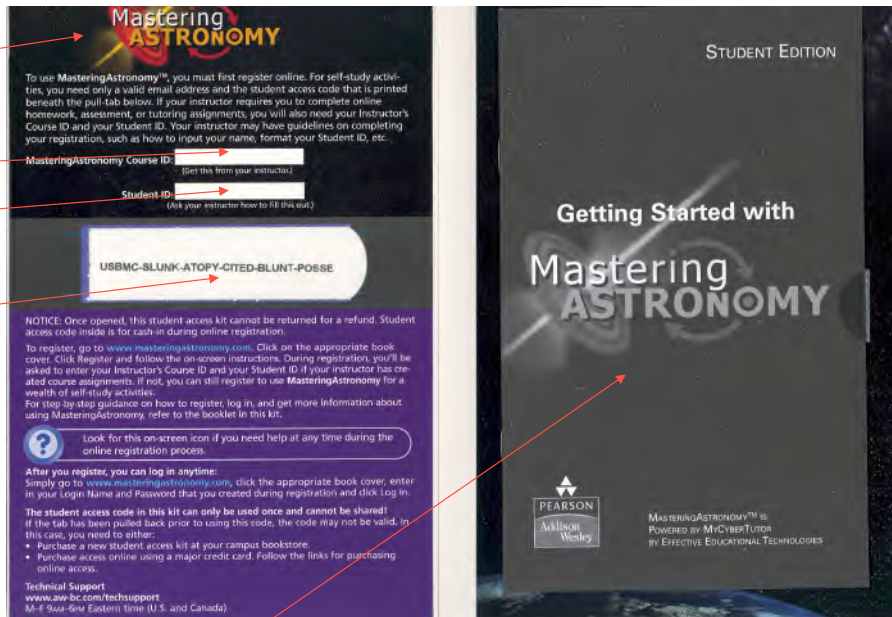

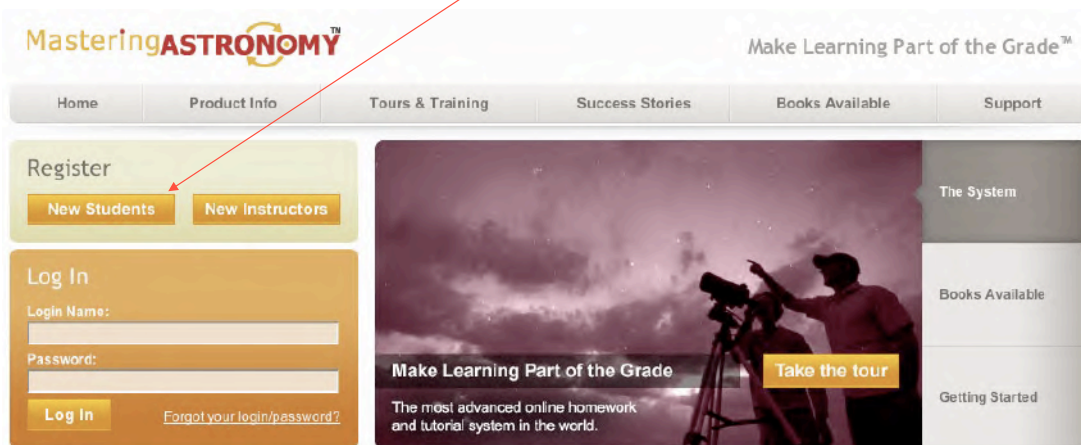
Pull back the tab to get a bunch of letters like this. Don't use these - They are already used!

Step 1: Do you have an access code?
